Equipment of the facility

The residence was built in 1903 and has been renovated and modernized during the last few years. Right next to the house you will find a nice park and huge garden.

The Clemens-Högg-House offers room for 48 residents in six groups on four floors. Most of them are single-rooms, a few double-rooms and apartments with a kitchen unit and bathroom.

If needed, furniture can be provided, but of course you can also bring along your own furniture. Every residential group is equipped with a kitchen and lounge for everybody. Therefore, you have enough space for your private life as well as room for time in community.



Residents

In the six residential communities of the Clemens-Högg-House you will live together with other mentally impaired people. You need intensive care and support in your everyday life. The time of your stay is determined by your personal development and can be long-term.

Limited admission of people with:

- organic brain disorder
- primarily addiction
- relevant forensic prehistory
- mental deficiency
- care dependency and severely limited mobility

In those cases we will discuss whether the social psychiatric help in the Clemens-Högg-House is reasonable.

Offer

Overlooking your individual abilities and impairment you will be encouraged and supported in all areas of life.

This contains:

- Furtherance of your mental stability
- Medical support
- Assertiveness training concerning medication and collaboration with doctors
- Psychosocial services, such as furtherance of your people skills, conflict counselling and crisis intervention
- Support and practice, including housekeeping, hygiene and design of your room
- Activities with main emphasis on exercise, trips and culture
- Your personal case manager

Aims

If you develop sufficient abilities and the willingness to participate, it is our aim to support you to make your life and living as independent as possible. Considering that we will additionally organize further ambulant help for you.

Centre for education and training of working skills (BTZ)

The BTZ is situated in the outbuilding and helps you to structure your workweeks. You will be occupied with either serial operation, in the garden, in the kitchen/cafeteria or the BTZ-shop.

The opportunities of work are diverse and will be determined individually. As well we have creative and artistic offers.

Our staff

Our care staff commands different qualifications within the range of social occupations. Everyone has their own responsibility concerning care and living communities in the house. At night there is an on-call team. In order to keep our quality, our staff is regularly consulted and supervised. They also continue their education.

Location and how to find us

The Clemens-Högg-House is located in Augsburg-Göggingen, with a five-minute distance to the town centre with its shops, restaurants, cafés and public pool.

The tramway number 1 is very close. You can also reach us easily by car.
