Who are we?

The Lotte-Lemke-Centre is a facility of the in-patient inclusion service for adults with a mental impairment who

- cannot live on their own for the next few months or years
- want this kind of care and are willing and able to participate in our offers

We offer person-centred care – it is our aim to make your life as independent and realistic as possible by providing the ideal furtherance.

Basics of your everyday life are how to establish relationships, find useful occupation, improve your lifestyle (diet, exercise, health care etc.)

Our offers:

Mental dependability

Motivation, perception and feedback, creation of a correspondence to reality, support and counselling as well as easing your burdens via discussions are a few examples of our psychosocial service. Individual service will be arranged and supervised by your case manager. In an emergency we provide crisis intervention.

Relationships

Communication is very important and we focus on honest and appreciative companionship.

Activity and work

We request regular attendance at the BTZ.

Daily routine

We motivate you and accompany activities, e.g. practice, parties, culture.

Self supply and living

We promote healthy food and drinks. The living groups cook together easy, delicious and cheap meals. Everyone helps and takes part as much as possible.



Medicines and care

We provide basic nursing but we cannot offer treatment care. When indicated, we assign the mobile nursing service.

Our residence offers

The Lotte-Lemke-Centre is located in the quiet suburb of Kaufbeuren. It is a well-spaced property with a garden. We host nine living groups in three buildings and offer lots of possibilities to practice a realistic daily routine with an independent lifestyle. All living groups are designed appreciatively and mostly consist of single-bedrooms. You can bring your own furniture if you want. The sanitary area is shared by two clients at the most. The kitchen is well-provided and there are enough washers and dryers.



Aims

It is our aim to support your personal resources (e.g. feelings, self-respect, attentiveness). We want to include our clients in society as much as possible.

Our staff

The group-staff consists of pedagogical professionals (social care workers, educators/teachers, specialised nurses for psychiatry) and assistances. We observe the line of modern social psychiatric conduct and steadily increase our quality management. Due to distinct responsibility we offer orientation and structure. Every client has their own person of reference so called case manager. Our facility is occupied 24/7. Consultation, team-supervision, in- and external further education and, last but not least, our offer is rounded by the active collaboration with the advisory council of the facility.

Centre for education and training of working skills (BTZ)

Activities and work take place in an area very close to the residential buildings.

How to reach us?

The admission is processed by the AWO social psychiatric counselling centre.

They will appoint the first interview, show you around and inform you about specific conditions. We also offer the possibility of living on probation – if you (as the potential resident), the living group, the BTZ, the social psychiatric counselling centre and the head of the facility agree in the final interview that the Lotte-Lemke-Centre is the right place for you to be, you can move in.
